Flux Ltd owns and operated the brand Axwel (referred to hereafter as the "Company", "we", "us", "our", "Axwel"), found at www.axwel.com. Flux Ltd is duly registered in Comoros Union with a registration number HT00525055, regulated by MISA (MWALI International Services Authority) with a brokerage license number BFX2025069 and registered office address at Bonovo Road – Fomboni Island of Moheli, Comoros Union.

When Clients access the website ("visitor(s)", "they", "them"), we may collect identifiable or non-identifiable information with the use of cookies and log data.

Definitions

"Cookies": small text files that are placed on the Client's computer/browser or device when they visit a website. Their computer stores it in a file located on web browser. They are used to help thebrowser remember their choices and display personalized information. Furthermore, they are used to make websites work, provide features, or function efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owner of the site, i.e. pages visited, number of visitors etc. Some cookies also enable the display of relevant advertising.

"Third Party Cookie": a cookie provided by a third party (e.g. Google Analytics) for which we have no control over.

"Session": If a cookie does not contain an expiration date, it is considered a session cookie. Session cookies are stored in memory and never written on disk. When the browser closes, the cookie is permanently lost from this point on.

"Persistent": cookies which stay in one of your browser's subfolders until the Client deletes them manually, or the browser deletes them based on the duration period contained within the persistent cookie's file.

Depending on the cookie type, the Company keeps track of different activities and data. For a detailed list of cookies, please refer to the Policy below.

A. Axwel Cookies

Various types of cookies are used on the website.

- Essential cookiesfor the functioning of the Company's website(s) that enable visitors to navigate the site (a.k.a. necessary cookies).
- Performance cookies for tracking visitor interaction with the site, providing insights into time spent on the site and any encountered issues.

Data collected from necessary and performance cookies does not personally identify Clients. However, opting not to accept these cookies may impact overall use experience.

Functionality and/or advertising cookies may be used to offer more personalized experience and deliver content that aligns with Clients' preferences. Additionally, advertising cookies are used to track the effectiveness of marketing campaigns. Please note that the Company may collect personally identifiable information using such cookies.

By accessing the Site, we collect information that Clients' browsers send whenever a website or online service is visited ("Log Data"). This Log Data may include, but is not limited to, your computer's IP address, browser type, the webpage you visited before arriving on our Site, as well as any searches you performed on the Site and our services.

Functional cookies	These cookies are essential for running our Site. Without these cookies, our Site would not function properly. They are temporarily savedas login information and expire once the browser is closed.

Analytical cookies	Analytical cookies allow us to analyze					
	patterns of visitor behavior and we use that					
	information to enhance the overall

	that may require maintenance. The data					
	collected is anonymous (i.e. it cannot be					
	used to identify the Client and does not					
	contain personal information such as their					
	name and email address, and it is only used					
	for statistical purposes.					
Promotional cookies	These cookies are used to treat visitors					
	These cookies are used to track visitors					
	across websites. The purpose of these					
	cookies is to display advertisements that are					
	relevant and engaging for the visitor.					
Preferences cookies	Preference cookies enable the Site to					
	remember information that changes the way					
	the website behaves or looks, i.e. Clients'					
	preferred language or their region.					
Third-party Cookies	We may use third-party cookies to collect					
	anonymous statistics about how the Site is					
	being used and provide Clients with further					
	information that may be of interest to the					
	Client. As part of this process, our third-party					

partners may set their own cookies during Clients' visit.

To the extent that those cookies are not strictly necessary for the provision of our website and services, we will ask the Clients to consent to our use of cookies when they first visit our Website. Also, they can choose to disable or block these cookies in your browser but bear in mind that this may affect the functioning of the Website.

B. Managing Analytics Cookies

We use Google Analytics, which relies on cookies to help us understand how visitors use our website and how they interact with its features. This information allows us to personalize and improve your experience on our site. The data collected through these cookies is stored by Google and later used to analyze site usage and generate reports about website and internet activity.

Axwel may share aggregated information, i.e. queries and offers generated from your use of the website, including non-identifying information and Log Data, with third parties. This serves industry analysis, demographic profiling, and other commercial purposes. This also allows us to deliver targeted advertising. Any aggregated information shared in these contexts will not contain any personal information.

D. Managing Cookies

Axwel respects your privacy, and we herein provide you with all information needed to manage the cookies you receive from web services. For the use of the platform, essential cookies are necessary. Opting out of these cookies will affect the provision of the relevant services and platform's functionality.
